### VICTORIAN CHILD SAFE STANDARDS

- 1. Organisations establish a culturally safe environment in which the diverse and unique identities and experiences of Aboriginal children and young people are respected and valued.
- 2. Child safety and wellbeing is embedded in organisational leadership, governance and culture.
- 3. Children and young people are empowered about their rights, participate in decisions affecting them and are taken seriously.
- 4. Families and communities are informed and involved in promoting child safety and wellbeing.
- 5. Equity is upheld and diverse needs respected in policy and practice.
- 6. People working with children and young people are suitable and supported to reflect child safety and wellbeing values in practice.
- 7. Processes for complaints and concerns are child-focused.
- 8. Staff and volunteers are equipped with the knowledge, skills and awareness to keep children and young people safe through ongoing education and training.
- 9. Physical and online environments promote safety and wellbeing while minimising the opportunity for children and young people to be harmed.
- 10. Implementation of the Child Safe Standards is regularly reviewed and improved.
- 11. Policies and procedures document how the organisation is safe for children and young people.
